

ASSIGNMENT CRITERIA

Associazione OTTIMO BACH, in the fulfillment of its statutory purposes, promotes the creation of Scholarships for the courses of the Scuola di Musica e del Rumore° .

For this purpose it seeks funds from public and private entities.

The scholarship is awarded on the basis of the following general criteria:

- In implementation of its pedagogical principles, Scuola di Musica e del Rumore° , while taking into due consideration factors such as "predisposition" or "talent", rejects their discriminatory value and promotes the importance of basic musical literacy for everyone, including individuals with disabilities, in whom specific musical resources are evident or who can draw therapeutic benefits from a path of musical activity.
- Scholarships are aimed at both further education and simple literacy.
- Scholarships are preferably addressed to children and young people under the age of 18, whose families are in conditions of economic hardship or who may have concrete difficulties in supporting the expenses for attending music courses. The economic conditions are certified by the ISEE model or self-certification.
- Scholarships are awarded without distinction of religious belief, sex or nationality.
- Scholarships can be titled.
- Scholarships can also be assigned to non-students of the Scuola di Musica e del Rumore° .

ECONOMIC EQUIPMENT

Based on the financial resources of the Scholars and the characteristics of their study program, Associazione OTTIMO BACH awards the following types of Scholarships:

- Ordinary Scholarship: provides for the full reimbursement of all expenses for participation in the educational activities of the School.

Supplementary Scholarship: provides for the following contributions, which cannot be combined

- > a contribution, of varying amounts, to the expenses for participation in the School's music courses;
- > the financing of a specific integration of the study program (theory, instrument, etc.);
- > additional help in support (availability of an instrument for daily study, individual pedagogical assistance, attendance of other complementary activities at other centers).

CONDITIONS OF MERIT

The Scholarship holder must demonstrate commitment, especially in carrying out the tasks that the activity may require, and maintain a constant attendance.

On the maintenance of the required levels of participation and profit, the Board of Directors of Associazione OTTIMO BACH expresses its final evaluation opinion.
